KINGS LANDING

Kings Landing is dedicated to drawing in, captivating, enhancing, and educating both the residents of New Brunswick and visitors. This is achieved through the presentation of a meticulously researched portrayal of the lives of individuals who inhabited the St. John River Valley during the 19th century.

LAKE GEORGE FAMILY CAMPGROUND

The campground provides 27 seasonal sites with campfire rings and picnic tables. Amenities include changing houses, toilets, a sandy beach, boat ramp, and recreational facilities. Public access for swimming is available for a small car entrance fee, and a canteen offers drinks, snacks, sunscreen, and bug spray.

HARVEY LAKE

Near Harvey village, Harvey Lake is a popular spot with a dock and boat launch. Along Cherry Mountain's base, railroad tracks run by the water. Adjacent to the lake is Taylor Field, hosting the annual Community Days Celebration

Harvey, NB proudly houses a 15 foot tall sculpture of the cherished fiddle of legendary Canadian musician Don Messer. This iconic instrument played a key role in Messer's historic performances, making Harvey a unique destination for those wanting to connect with the rich musical heritage of the region.
